God's Timing is Always Perfect!

Back in August 2024, I noticed an incoming call. Usually, I ignore the call if I don't recognize the phone number. This time I decided to receive the call. The person on the other end identified himself as Gil Campos. He said I am trying to get a hold of Johnny Sylvester. I answered, this is Johnny Sylvester (family name of course). Gil continued, I am your Nino and I promised your mother I would check up on you and make sure you're ok. I have been looking for you for the past 50 years. Gil asked me if I was overwhelmed. I answered no, I am over excited. We have talked several times since that August 2024 momentous call. For the past several years, I have longed for contact with my family. I knew this was impossible as nearly all of my family members have passed away and I don't have any contact #'s or emails for the remaining kinsfolk. God reminded me that I indeed have a family, a "spiritual" family.

God's love for us

From the day I accepted Jesus to be my personal savior, I had become His child, by the will of God! There was nothing I could do on my own, to bridge the gap between myself and God. It was God's love for us that accomplished this "unattainable work" by sinful man. Jesus Christ is God's only provision for our sin. John 3:16, states "For God so loved the world that he gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life."
