The Heart of a Shepherd

Give Thanks

On October 3, 1863, President Abraham Lincoln proclaimed that the last Thursday of November would be "a day of Thanksgiving and Praise to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens." In **Psalm 107** the word give thanks is mentioned five times. Give thanks to the Lord for His goodness and for His wonderful works to the children of men. We use the phrase, "God is good, all the time God is good." That is a very true statement which should cause us to give thanks at all times.

There were ten lepers who cried out to Jesus to have mercy on them with the intent of being healed from their leprosy. Jesus extended His mercy on them and told them to show themselves to the priest and as they went, they were healed. You remember that only one of the ten returned. He took the time and the Bible declares in **Luke 17** that he returned and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks.

Back in **Psalm 107** there is a phrase that precedes give thanks to the Lord for His goodness and for His wonderful works to the children of men. The phrase is "**Oh, that men would give thanks.**" The people were in distress and afflicted at various times and they cried out to the Lord and He saved and delivered them. It appears that they were not giving thanks for His goodness and for His wonderful works. When God responded to their cries it seems they didn't express any gratitude to God.

One thing I have noticed over the years of being at OCC, whether praying before we set up or after we tear down and all the times in between, the prayers always start off with thank You Lord for..... OCC is a thankful church that is aware of God's goodness. **1 Thessalonians 5:18 "In everything give thanks for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."**

On this thanksgiving week and this Thanksgiving Day and every day for the remainder of our time here on earth, we thank You Lord for Your goodness and for Your wonderful works to the children of men.
