The Heart of an Shepherd

Good morning, we certainly appear to be living in perilous times. Is it just me or does it seem like we, as a society and as a nation, are on the last leg of the journey?

How are we to know that we are nearer the end than when we first believed? How are we to know that Jesus Christ's return is eminent? Does scripture give us any clear indication of what we shall see and what we will experience prior to our Savior's return?

2 Timothy 3:1–5 "But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³ unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, ⁴ traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!"

They look like the real deal; they talk like the real deal, but they do not have the Holy Spirit indwelling them. **2 Timothy 3:5b** "And from such people turn away!"

In the following verse, **Titus 1:16**, the Apostle Paul tells us plainly & simply:

- What these men will claim "They profess to know God"
- How these men will deny Him "but in works they deny Him"
- What that will look like "being abominable, disobedient"
- And what these men are disqualified to do "disqualified for every good work."

Titus 1:16 "They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work."

The Apostle Paul gives us clear instruction as to how to approach such people. **2 Timothy 3:5b** "And from such people turn away!"

The Apostle Paul also gives the church instruction in how to act in these perilous times. **Romans 13:11–14** "And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. ¹² The night is far **spent**, **the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.** ¹³ Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. ¹⁴ But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts."

Wake up church, pay attention saints, we are nearer the end than when we first believed. We are in the midst of perilous times, yet God is with us, and He is for us.

1 Peter 5:6–7 "Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, 7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you."

May our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ bless you this day and all the days of your life.
