Blessed Assurance

As a believer, we have a degree of confidence and assurance in dealing with all aspects of life that non-believers simply do not understand. The Holy Spirit has been pointing this out to me in countless ways lately. Everywhere I turn I am struck by yet another example. Many years ago, Fanny Crosby must have felt the same way when she penned the hymn "Blessed Assurance". The first verse goes as follows:

**"Blessed assurance, Jesus is mine
O what a foretaste of glory divine
Heir of salvation, purchase of God
Born of His Spirit, washed in His blood"**

What a marvelous thing the Creator of the universe has done for each and every one of us personally. All that power, all that might, yet He has all His love focused on each of us. How can we even begin to think that our problems are too big, that our worries are too overwhelming, our lives too lost, for the Almighty God to handle? He not only can do it, He wants to! How can we know this and not tell everyone that we can? How can we know this and not praise and worship Him with everything we are and everything we do? The chorus of that old hymn goes like this:

**"This is my story
This is my song
Praising my Savior all the day long"**

May you make this your story. May you make this your song. May you praise your Savior, all the day long.

Philippians 1:6 "being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;"

As well as **John 10:26-29, John 14:16-18, John 14:25-30, John 17:12-15, 1 Corinthians 10:13-14, James 4:7, Hebrews 6:17-20, 1 Peter 1:3-6, 1 John 5:18, Revelation 3:10, 2 Corinthians 1:22, 2 Thessalonians 3:3,** and countless more.
