## The Heart of a Shepherd

**Revelation 19:6** *"And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, 'Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!'"*

We've probably all seen Leonardo da Vinci's famous painting, "The Last Supper" at some time in our lives. Jesus is sitting at a table with six disciples on each side. The painting is not accurate in many ways, but the main inaccuracy is in the title, "The Last Supper".

It wasn't the LAST Supper!

Jesus ate many times with His disciples after He rose from the grave. Scripture also mentions some suppers coming up in the future. The **"great supper of God"**, **Revelation 19:17-21** which we don't want to be any part of, and the **"marriage supper of the Lamb"**, **Revelation 19:7-9** which we long for: **"Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready. <sup>8</sup> And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. <sup>9</sup> Then he said to me, 'Write: "Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!"' And he said to me, 'These are the true sayings of God.'"**

We've never been able to dine with the Lord, but the day is coming when all true believers will be called to the dinner table as we join our Bridegroom. What a joyous day it will be when we see Jesus face to face, worshipping Him and enjoying sweet communion by feasting, not in remembrance, but in the presence of our Lord as we truly partake of the Lord's table.
