"Trust the Lord" Proverbs 3:5-6

One of my favorite verses for the past 15 years has been **Proverbs 3:5-6**"trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and he will make your paths straight."

Trust in the Lord is a hard thing to do when you may have grown up being let down from an early age into adult life. You come to the Lord with great expectations but trusting God for every situation seems so overwhelming. "lean not on your own understanding." When we think we can resolve a situation on our own without placing it before God, asking His will to be done. We are headed down a slippery slope. One foot on a banana peel, the other foot on an oil slick.

Isaiah 55:8-9 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways' declares the Lord. 'As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.'"

"in all your ways submit to Him." It's not just choosing the most "overwhelming" challenge in our lives to take before God. God wants us to trust Him for everything from the most difficult to the least mundane concerns. We forget that God wants to hear about all matters, life is unpredictable and may be very stressful. It is recognizing and trusting in God's guidance and in every aspect of our lives. God's faithfulness always prevails.
