Chicken and Rice Casserole

1-bone in chicken cut up or 6-8 thighs or 4-5 breasts
3 cups minute rice 1 can cream of celery soup
1 can cream of mushroom soup 1 can cream of chicken soup
1 package dry onion soup

Clean and trim chicken. Sometimes I remove the skin off the breast. In a bowl mix rice, canned soups and ½ of the onion soup. Spread out the rice mixture in a 9X13 baking pan and place the chicken on top of the rice. Sprinkle chicken with the remaining ½ of dry onion soup and season with pepper, and garlic salt. Cover pan with foil and bake at 350 degrees for about 2 hours.

Mixed Roasted Vegetables

Dice in bite size:

Bell peppers, onions, zucchini, yellow, squash, mushroom buttons, broccoli, cauliflower, Brussel sprouts, any other you like. Place in a bowl and toss with olive oil and your favorite spices. Spread onto parchment paper on a cookie sheet. Roast in a 375 degree oven for about 25 minutes or until tender and lightly brown.

Peach Cobbler

2 cups peeled & sliced peaches ¼ cup butter
½ cup flour 1 cup sugar or ½ c. Truvia
1 tsp. baking powder ½ tsp. salt
1/3 cup milk 1 egg
¼ tsp. vanilla ½ tsp. cinnamon
¼ tsp. nutmeg ¼ cup brown sugar

Preheat oven to 350 degrees . Put butter in a 9-inch glass pan and place in oven to melt while oven is preheating. Mix flour, 2/3 cup of sugar or Truvia, baking powder and salt in large bowl. Add milk and egg to flour mixture and stir. Put peaches in a bowl and stir in remaining sugar with vanilla, cinnamon and nutmeg. Pour batter mixture into the melted butter, DO NOT STIR. Spoon peaches over the batter in the pan, sprinkle brown sugar on top. Bake for 40-45 minutes.
