

## *From Janet's Kitchen*

### Stuffed Burgers

1-1/2 pounds ground beef  
Garlic salt, pepper, season salt  
Sliced onion  
Sliced marinated mushrooms  
1 tablespoon olive oil  
Sliced American or Swiss cheese  
Crumbled bacon

Mix meat, olive oil and seasoning together. Pattie out 3 ounces of ground meat into 4-inch patties, you will be making 8 patties. Top 4 patties with the cheese, and any one or two of the other options. Top the patty with another patty, making sure you leave the edges of the patties free of food so you can seal them. With a fork seal the two patties together leaving no openings for leakage. Place on grill or fry pan, cooking on medium heat.

### Baked Fries

3 tablespoons olive oil  
½ teaspoon garlic salt  
Pepper to taste  
1 tablespoon chopped rosemary  
½ cup chopped onion  
2 pounds potatoes cut in fourths

Heat oven to 425 degrees. Spray baking sheet with nonstick spray. In a large bowl toss together oil, rosemary, garlic salt, onion, pepper and potatoes. Spread evenly onto prepared pan. Bake 30-35 minutes, stirring occasionally until fork tender and golden brown.

### Frozen Grasshopper Squares

28 Oreo cookies  
1 container of mint-chocolate chip ice cream, softened  
1 8-ounce tub of Cool whip  
1 square semi-sweet chocolate, grated

Line a 13X9 inch pan with foil, with ends of foil extending over sides. Crush 20 cookies; sprinkle crumbs onto bottom of prepared pan. Spread ice cream evenly over crumbs in pan, top with cool whip and grated chocolate. Freeze 3 hours. Remove from freezer 15 minutes before serving. Let stand at room temperature to soften slightly. Lift dessert from pan with foil handles; cut into 16 squares. Place ½ Oreo on top of each square.

The author has left the following account regarding the writing of this hymn: "It was written in a very simple fashion, without thought of publication. Whit Monday is a great day for school festivals in Yorkshire, and one Whit Monday it was arranged that our school should join forces with that of a neighboring village to the other, but couldn't think of anything quite suitable, so I sat up at night resolved to write something myself. "Onward Christian Soldiers" was the result. It was written in great haste and I am afraid that some of the rhymes are faulty. I am certain that nothing has surprised me more than its popularity.

Vs. 1 Onward Christian Soldiers, marching as to war, with the cross of Jesus going on before! Christ, the royal Master, leads against the foe, forward into battle see His banner go!

Chorus: Onward, Christian soldiers, marching as to war, with the cross of Jesus going on before!

Vs. 2 At the time of triumph Satan's host doth flee, On, then, Christian soldiers, on to victory! Hell's foundations quiver at the shout of praise; brother, lift your voices, loud your anthems raise!

Vs. 3 Like a mighty army moves the church of God; brothers, we are treading where the saints have trod, we are not divided, all one body we—One in hope and doctrine, One in charity.
